

The Cameron — Boley House 25 Main Street West, Huntsville c. 1910

"Mr. Cameron owns a handsome residence on Main Street." So wrote *The Forester* in 1906. This "handsome residence" was designed by the renowned William Proudfoot and built in 1904 for Alexander Cameron on land bought from Allan and Mary Shay for \$155.50.

The solid brick house, with double two-storey bay windows, is situated on the height of land overlooking Hunter's Bay. Above the windows are flattened brick voussiers, an attractive detail. Notice the swag drapes, and blinds pulled half-way down, so typical of the period. A pediment is added to the porch entrance.
